### SAF Rule Revisions

<p><b>Regulation 9: Application for membership</b> – Page 6</p> <p>(1) To apply to become a member of the Association, a person must submit a written application to a committee member stating that the person—</p> <p>(a) wishes to become a member of the Association; and</p> <p>(b) supports the purposes of the Association; and</p> <p>(c) agrees to comply with these Rules.</p> <p>(2) The application—</p> <p>(a) must be signed by the applicant; and</p> <p>(b) may be accompanied by the joining fee.</p>	<p>“A person who applies to be a Member of the Sport Aircraft Association of Australia Inc. will at the same time apply to be a Member of the Sport Aircraft Facilities Inc. by way of a joint application submitted to the Secretary of the Sport Aircraft Association of Australia Inc.”</p>
<p><b>Regulation 10: Consideration of application</b> - Page 6</p> <p>(1) As soon as practicable after an application for membership is received, the Committee must decide by resolution whether to accept or reject the application.</p> <p>(2) The Committee must notify the applicant in writing of its decision as soon as practicable after the decision is made.</p> <p>(3) If the Committee rejects the application, it must return any money accompanying the application to the applicant.</p> <p>(4) No reason need be given for the rejection of an application.</p>	<p>“In accordance with Rule 9, the Committee accepts that a person who has applied to be a Member of the Sport Aircraft Association of Australia Inc. and of the Sports Aircraft Facilities Inc. and who has been accepted as a Member of the Sport Aircraft Association of Australia Inc. shall be accepted by the Committee as a Member of the Sport Aircraft Facilities Inc. on condition that a joining fee will be paid to Sport Aircraft Facilities Inc. by the Sport Aircraft Association of Australia Inc. for and on behalf of each member from membership funds paid by each member to join the Sport Aircraft Association of Australia Inc.”</p>
<p><b>Regulation 11: New membership</b> - Page 6</p> <p>(1) If an application for membership is approved by the Committee—</p> <p>(a) the resolution to accept the membership must be recorded in the minutes of the committee meeting; and</p> <p>(b) the Secretary must add new members to the members register when advised by the SAAA Secretary, that a new member has been joined to SAAA Inc., entering the name and address of the new member, and the date of becoming a member, in the register of members. 7 January 2015</p>	<p>“In accordance with Rules 8, 9 and 10 the register of Members of Sport Aircraft Facilities Inc. will be represented in its entirety by the register of Members of the Sport Aircraft Association of Australia Inc.</p> <p>A person who becomes a member of the Association and, subject to rule 13(2), is entitled to exercise his or her rights of membership from the date-on which-in accordance with Rules 8, 9 and 10 they become a Member.”</p>

<p>(2) A person becomes a member of the Association and, subject to rule 13(2), is entitled to exercise his or her rights of membership from the date, whichever is the later, on which—</p> <p>(a) the Committee approves the person's membership; or</p> <p>(b) the person pays the joining fee.</p>	
<p><b>Regulation 12: Annual subscription and fee on joining</b> - Page 7</p> <p>(1) At each annual general meeting, the Association must determine—</p> <p>(a) the amount of the annual subscription (if any) for the following financial year; and</p> <p>(b) the date for payment of the annual subscription.</p>	<p>(1) “The joining fee shall be \$0.01 per member and the annual subscription shall be nil unless the Association determines otherwise at an annual general meeting, in which case, the Association must determine –</p> <p>(a) The amount of the annual subscription (if any) for the following financial year; and</p> <p>(b) The Association may ... etc etc as per current Rules”</p>
